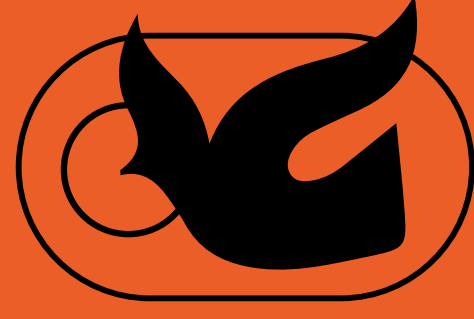

# Our Vision

Freedom School of Ministry (FSM) exists to **RAISE REVIVALISTS.**

We are devoted to readying and training people to become presence-centred disciples. People who are becoming an uncontested resting place for God and an undeniable place of encounter for the world.

Our training focuses on both the physical and spiritual requirements of leadership. We want to see people learn how to commune deeply with God, develop dependence on His Word and live in the power and demonstration of the Holy Spirit, by discovering and putting into practice their spiritual gifts.

FSM offers three levels of training, including **Foundation**, **Formation** and **Leadership**, meaning there's training available to everyone, regardless of where you are in your discipleship.

Students are challenged to uncover their calling as a Kingdom leader by undertaking training in a range of environments including Classroom, Practical Streams and Mentor Based Training.



# Our Values

If we are to fulfil all of God's purposes for our lives, it's imperative we first understand both who we are becoming and who we are not becoming.

As students of FSM and ultimately, of Christ, we are commissioning you to adopt the following Kingdom Values as the reference point for the different people God is calling us to be.

# Foundation

Four eight-week courses, running across each of the FSM school terms focused on equipping you with the necessary foundational truths for discipleship.

## **What does it cost?**

\$100 per course (\$400 annually)  
Includes course curriculum only

# Formation

Mature into the person God has called you to be, by discovering the gifts of the Holy Spirit on your life and by learning to live in the discipline of the Holy Spirit as you re-centre your life around Jesus and His kingdom.

\$1000 annually with 50% up-front  
Includes orientation, curriculum, retreat, graduation dinner and tea & coffee

# Leadership

Gritty preparation for the rigors of Kingdom leadership. Learn to partner with the Holy Spirit in authority to see the heart of God released through you. Understand God's desire for the Church through the five-fold governance and graces.

# What to expect from the FSM leadership team

We will do our utmost to treat you like the disciple and leader you are training to become. Here is what you can expect from our trainers and leaders during your time in training at FSM, depending on the level of training being undertaken:

# Expectations of FSM Students

We expect that you will both enjoy and honour your time as a student, feeling free to take the risk of becoming all who God has called you to be, while also doing the hard work of cooperating with the confronting nature of being deeply transformed by the Holy Spirit.

Believe it or not, He will often use people as His agents of change. In the context of your training, this will be your trainers and leaders, many of which volunteer themselves. Our expectation is you would also honour their time and spiritual oversight over your life during this season of training.

## Expectations for graduation

The following requirements must be met in order for students to successfully graduate at Freedom School of Ministry:

- A minimum class attendance of 80%
- Attendance at Retreat for students undertaking Formation or Leadership training
- Completion of Orientation prior to commencement of each level of training
- 100% completion of hours in assigned Practical Stream
- Attendance to Sunday Service, including monthly PM Encounter Services
- Participation in a midweek Group
- Attendance to quarterly All-in Leader meetings
- Participation in four major Nameless Faceless Events

# Attendance

As an FSM student, we are focused on who you are becoming when we think about how we want you to be treated. This means we treat you like a leader. Thus, it's expected that all students fulfil their commitment of attendance as outlined in the Expectations for Graduation. Students will also be encouraged to prioritise participating in at least two All-in Prayer gatherings each month.

If for any reason you are unable to attend any of the specified events, please call or text your School oversight well ahead of time to allow ample time for review and discussion.

# Attire

Dress with distinction from the dying world to whom we are representing Jesus. Modesty and cleanliness are the plumb lines you can use when it comes to attire, with "smart-casual" being a good guideline if you're unsure. We want to present ourselves as the prepared people we are, avoiding pyjamas, track suits, ugg boots etc.

# Integrity

Paul tells us that we are like living letters who are being observed by all people. Even more compelling is the truth that God is the first witness to both our hidden and public life. Nothing is hidden from Him. We've been called to live holy lives before God and others (1 Pet 1:16). In all things, seen and unseen, we must determine whether we are rightly representing Jesus and His gospel.

This includes giving careful consideration to your social media presence, and how this honours God and others.

# Responsibility

Remain aware of how any changes to how you serve, will impact the teams and people involved. Always communicate quickly and clearly with your Stream and School oversights, and own the responsibility of seeking out a replacement for your role, if you cannot fulfil your commitment for any reason.

We're called to be faithful with every responsibility we have been entrusted with, so hold every opportunity in high esteem. Some simple ways you can do this when serving is to arrive early, take initiative and serve wholeheartedly rather than reluctantly.

# Facilities

You'll notice there is one recurring theme in Jesus' teaching about Kingdom leadership - stewardship. We thoroughly believe in this Kingdom principle and that God is testing our preparedness for stewarding greater authority and greater responsibility when we manage well what we have already been given, no matter how small.

Thus, all students are responsible for the care and upkeep of the space while being used for training. Cleaning and tear-down will be rostered between all students with rosters uploaded to the **Student Hub** facilitated by Google Classroom.



## General Information

### SCHOOL TIMES

Currently FSM is running weekly on Tuesday evening from 6.30pm - 9.30pm. Our annual training schedule follows that of the standard Victorian schooling terms and semesters.

A detailed timetable is available on the **Student Hub** via Google Classroom.

### ASSIGNMENTS

Students undertaking Formation and Leadership training will be given the opportunity to apply what they have learned through written assessments. The competence level required for all assessments have been carefully weighed and considered for each level of training. Assessments will have a deadline of at least 14 days from the date of distribution. A penalty of -5% per day will apply for late submissions. A grading of less than 50% will result in failure of the assessment.

### DEVOTIONALS

All students will have the opportunity to share a short three-minute devotional at the beginning of each evening of training, as part of maintaining a focus of being with Jesus before training for Him. Devotional rosters can be found on the **Student Hub** on Google Classroom.

### SAFE MINISTRY

Upon registration, FSM students are required to undergo Safe Church training which will include the completion of a Working with Children Check. This will be required in order for you to be deployed into areas of service. All checks and courses must be submitted and completed prior to February 28.



# **Practical Streams**

Students undertaking Formation or Leadership training will be required to serve a minimum of three Sunday services each month, within their assigned practical stream. Streams include a number of different areas of service across Sunday services. We encourage you to serve at the highest capacity you can rather than limit yourself to what is required.

Student practicum is an included component of assessment contributing towards end of year results. Thus, students will be required to log their hours of service and submit with their school oversight each week.

# **Retreat**

Retreats are currently held twice across the schooling year and offer the opportunity for Students to be poured into by training and leadership teams, to spend time in worship together and receive impartation.

Retreat fees for students undertaking Formation or Leadership training are covered in annual schooling fees. Fees will be disclosed in advance for Foundation students who are also invited to attend.



# Missions

Students will also be given the opportunity to travel abroad to witness and participate in the ongoing mission work of Freedom Ministries International. Dates and details relating to cost and travel itinerary will be disclosed early in the schooling year to allow time to plan and budget accordingly.

# Additional Training

Students undertaking Formation or Leadership training are encouraged to maintain a posture of readiness and availability to attend and serve at additional church events and gatherings, to be engaged in prayer ministry and support as well as coordinated evangelism efforts in partnership with our Outreach & Evangelism teams.

Your time in FSM will likely be a faster-paced season than others that will require you to steward your time wisely. Part of your discipleship will be learning how to intentionally carve out time for rest and delight and to meet with God daily.





## When is FSM happening?

Training is held weekly on Tuesday from 6.30pm - 9.30pm. The FSM 2025 curriculum year commences on February 4 for Foundation students and February 11 for Formation and Leadership students.

## What do I need?

To be best prepared you'll need to have a Bible. A study Bible is recommended, though not necessary. Plus a note-taker of your preference, be that a device or pen and notebook.
